

## Priority at junctions:

# Left turn (major road to minor road)

Normally the traffic on the major road has priority. You need to be aware that some drivers may not give you priority – you need to check all around you for traffic and try to make eye contact with drivers to make sure they have seen you.

Take a look at the diagram below: Cyclist **A** is approaching the junction. Number the 5 steps in the circles below into the correct order from 1-5.

| <input type="radio"/> Give a lifesaver look back.  | <input type="radio"/> Go! Turn left into the junction staying reasonably close to the 3 kerb. Look out for traffic turning in front of you and give way to any pedestrians crossing the road. |
| <input type="radio"/> Look back as you approach the junction.                            | <input type="radio"/> Put both hands back on.   |
| <input type="radio"/> Signal clearly with the left arm – holding for at least 3 seconds. |   |
